Boys Should Wear:

1. Dress Pants, preferably black but khakis will be allowed
2. Dark Dress Socks
3. Dress Shoes (Preferably Dark) (**NO** Tennis Shoes) (Dress boots are allowed)
4. Dress Shirt (Preferably White)
5. Tie
6. Graduation cap must be worn flat on head
7. Cap and/or gown cannot be decorated or altered in any way

Girls Should Wear:

1. A dress
2. Low dress heels, **NO** flip flops
3. Graduation cap must be worn flat on head
4. Cap and/or gown cannot be decorated or altered in any way
